Drug addiction is a chronic disorder that refers to the condition in which a person feels a strong need of drugs and can't keep from consuming the same. It is characterized by obsessive engagement in desired spur despite adverse consequences. The addictive stimuli are characterized by two factors – one is positive reinforcement and second is perceived to be intrinsically rewarding.
